2011 VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

The driving distance to the various trails range from 15 minutes to upwards of an hour. Please figure your gas, food, and water needs before start of trail lineups each morning. All vehicles will be inspected for tow points front and rear, seat belts for all passengers, battery tie downs, and a full size spare. It is recommended that you also carry a snatch strap, CB or FRS radio, fire extinguisher, first aid kit, common replacement parts for your rig, and a jack. Other equipment or modifications may also be required depending on the trail or degree of difficulty.

Stock Class

Rating: 3-4

Requirements: Above requirements and; disconnecting your front sway bar will help in certain situations. Also, more aggressive tire tread styles will fare better.

Intermediate Class

Rating: 5-6

Requirements: Above requirements and; 32-33" MUD tires. One locker extremely helpful.

Advanced Class

Rating: 7-10

Requirements: Above requirements and; 33" tires with 2 lockers or 35" tires with 1 locker, winch. A winch is *always* recommended.

Absolutely no alcohol will be allowed on any trail.
